Feast of the Holy Family December 31

Solemnity of Mary, Holy Mother of God Ianuarv 1st

The angel said to Mary, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born will called Holy, The Son of God." - Luke 1:35

The Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God is a liturgical celebration observed on January 1 which falls exactly one week after Christmas, the end of the octave of Christmas.

The Blessed Virgin Mary is honoured as the Mother of God because she conceived and gave birth to Christ, who is the incarnation of God the Son, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity. It is fitting to honour Mary as Mother of Jesus, following the birth of Christ. When Catholics celebrate the Solemnity of Mary Mother of God, we are not only honouring Mary, who was chosen among all women throughout history to bear God incarnate, but we are also honouring our Lord, who is fully God and fully human.

HOLIDAYS AND HOLY DAYS

The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) has decreed that the Holy Days of obligation to be observed in Canada are: all Sundays of the year, Christmas Day and the Feast of Mary, Mother of God (January 1st).

This year, the Feast of Mary, Mother of God, falls on a Monday.

The Sunday obligation can be fulfilled by attending Mass on Saturday evening or any time on Sunday.

The Feast of Mary, Mother of God obligation can be fulfilled at Mass on Sunday evening or any time on Monday.

However, the same Mass cannot meet both obligations.
