BAPTISMS

Parents themselves should pick up and return a completed Baptism Information Form to the parish office at least 6 months in advance of the anticipated baptismal date. An interview with a parish priest is required. Parents of children to be baptized should be registered members of our Parish Community. Attendance at a Baptismal Preparation Meeting is mandatory.

MARRIAGE

Couples themselves must contact the parish office at least *one full year in advance* of the anticipated marriage date. No date may be set before meeting with a priest. A Marriage Preparation Course is required. If either party has been previously married, permission to proceed must be obtained from the Chancery Office of the Archdiocese.

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT



The Third Sunday of Advent is traditionally known as *Gaudete Sunday*. Gaudete is a Latin word which means rejoice. We light the rose colored candle on our wreath as a sign of joy. We rejoice because the birthday of our Savior is near.

Have no anxiety at all, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, make your requests known to God. BLESSING FOR A CHRISTMAS CRIB

God and Father of us all, bless us as we prepare this crib and let it be reminder of the Lord Jesus who was born of the Virgin Mary in the City of David. Grant that we may always serve you in faith as did the angels, praise you for your saving deeds as the shepherds, and surround you with the warmth of our love as did the animals in the stable. We make this prayer through Christ our Lord. Amen!

HOW TO GO TO CONFESSION

The Sacrament of Reconciliation for Adult and Youth Cards are available for pick-up in front of the Confession Booth.

- Before going to Confession, examine your conscience by reflecting on your sins.
- Begin your Confession by saying "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Bless me Father for I have sinned. It has been [length of time] since my last Confession. These are my sins..."
- The priest will suggest something for you to do or pray after Confession (called penance), as a response to God's mercy.
- The priest will then ask you to pray the *Act of Contrition* (see below) out loud, demonstrating your sorrow for your sins.
- The priest will extend his hands in your direction and pray the Prayer of Absolution. You respond "Amen"
- The priest will likely say "God has freed you from your sins. God in peace." You can respond; "Thanks be to God."

ACT OF CONTRITION

My God, I am sorry for my sins with all my heart. In choosing to do wrong and failing to do good, I have sinned against you whom I should love above all things. I firmly intend, with the help of your grace, to do penance, to sin no more, and to avoid whatever leads me to sin. Our Saviour Jesus Christ suffered and died for us. In his name, O my God, have mercy.

Amen.


