#### **BAPTISMS**

Parents themselves should pick up and return a completed Baptism Registration Form to the Parish Office at least 6 months in advance of the anticipated baptismal date. An interview with a priest is required. Parents of children to be baptized should be registered members of our Parish. Attendance at a Baptismal Preparation Meeting is mandatory.

#### **MARRIAGE**

Couple themselves must contact the parish office at least *one full year in advance* of the anticipated marriage date. No date may be set before meeting with a priest.

Completion of a Marriage Preparation Course is required. If either party has been previously married, permission to proceed must be obtained from the Chancery of the Archdiocese.

Starting December 1st, the church will be open for adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on:

Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays from 8:30AM-12:15PM (Benediction at 12:15PM).

At Mass, the sacrifice of Christ is made present. The Eucharist allows us to stand at the foot of Calvary spiritually, experiencing the sacrifice that redeemed humanity.

Eucharistic adoration is seen as an extension of the Mass. When we look at the Host held in the monstrance during adoration, we're able to meditate on Christ, as he is there with us physically in the room. We deepen our relationship with Him through silent prayer.
