The Holy Eucharist is “the source and summit of the Christian life” (CCC 1324), the sacred gift through which Christ continually nourishes His Church with His presence, grace, and love. In every Mass, we are invited into the saving mystery of Christ’s sacrifice, the joy of His Real Presence, and deeper communion with God and one another.

At all Masses on May 30/31, we will incorporate a special Teaching Mass element as an opportunity to deepen your understanding and appreciation of the beauty, meaning, and richness of the Catholic liturgy. Throughout the celebration of the Mass, the prayers, gestures, symbols, and sacred traditions of our worship will be thoughtfully explained, helping us participate more fully and prayerfully in the Eucharist.

Whether you are a lifelong Catholic, new to the faith, or simply seeking to grow spiritually, this is a great opportunity to encounter Christ more deeply through the Church’s greatest prayer. All are welcome—parishioners, families, children, newcomers, and anyone desiring a deeper love for the Mass and the Holy Eucharist.

**SACRED HEART OF JESUS**

Friday June 12, 2026



Each year Holy Mother Church dedicates the month of June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus Christ. This devotion invites us to contemplate not only the mystery of Christ’s love, but also the kind of hearts we are called to develop in the world (Mt 11:29; Jn 13:34). When we refer to the

“Sacred Heart of Jesus” we recall the whole mystery of Christ - his Person, his mission and his infinite divine-human love for the Father and for humanity. As the Catechism teaches, Christ “has loved us all with a human heart”, and his pierced Heart is rightly considered “the chief sign and symbol of that love with which the divine Redeemer continually loves the eternal Father and all human beings” without exception (CCC, 478).
